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SUMMER 2017 EVENING COURSES

ECE 157 BEHAVIOUR GUIDANCE | 60 hours - Diploma or Level 1 Credit

This course focuses on assisting adults in a child care setting to understand children's behaviour as it is influenced by developmental and environmental factors. Students will learn practical skills for supporting and guiding healthy interaction between children and between adult and child. Discipline principles and techniques will be explored and applied in the context of curriculum, role modeling and appropriate intervention. This course will also assist the student in developing the ability to be sensitive to the child's developmental level, interests, need for interaction and support; and to be able to use a variety of developmentally appropriate positive guidance strategies while meeting the child's need to develop competence, dependence, independence, and conflict resolution skills. Students will examine the environment (curriculum, space, routines, transitions and people) as the key to supporting children's development, behaviour and resilience.

Prerequisite ECE 101 Child Growth and Development

Dates: June 13 to August 10, 2017
Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6:30 pm to 9:30 pm. *Please note there are two Saturday morning classes on June 17 and July 22.*

Fees: \$75 admin, \$800 tuition, \$50 student fee to be paid each academic year. Textbooks not included in fees.

GWE I & II GUIDED WORKPLACE EXPERIENCE – Level 1 Requirement

Participants for Level 1 Classification are required to provide proof of completion of two Guided Workplace Experiences that provide opportunities to link course work with practice. The GWE takes place in your own licensed centre.

Dates: GWE I and GWE II: June 22, to August 31, 2017
(Maximum 10 weeks) Introductory seminar
Wednesday, June 21, 2017 from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm
(mandatory)

Fees: \$75 administration fee, \$400 tuition fee.

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
